

## Manufacturing Cost Reporting and History Tracking

The QMRP™ Manufacturing Cost Reporting module accumulates costs for material, labor, overhead, and outside services against manufacturing orders and maintains a continual comparison to standard costs defined in the work center, routing, product structure, and inventory cost master files. Costs tracked by the system are user-defined as actual cost, average cost, or standard cost.

The Manufacturing History Tracking programs provide access to accumulated manufacturing transactions, including material, work order, labor, and lot tracking history reports and inquiries.

### Highlights:

- Detail reports and inquiries include labor, overhead, stock material, purchased material, purchased services, and adjustment costs against a manufacturing order, with comparisons to standard.
- Real-time status reports and inquiries detail order status, date picked, accumulated standard and actual costs to date, and projected costs to complete.
- Purchased material or services can be charged directly to specific manufacturing orders through the fully-interfaced Purchasing/Receiving module.
- Labor costs can be tracked as actual cost with overtime, actual cost without overtime, or at the standard labor rate defined in the work center and routing master files.
- Labor history reports and inquiries by manufacturing order, routing sequence, and employee include actual hours compared to earned hours.
- Material history reports and inquiries are available by distribution branch, item, and transaction date.
- Manufacturing order history reports and inquiries detail order history and summarize number of orders and order quantities, and calculate historical lead time, scrap, labor hours, efficiency, cost, and cost variance per unit averages.
- Lot trace history reports and inquiries detail origin or destination of lot controlled items.
- Lot costing is available.
- Group costing by sales order of all related (cross-referenced) manufacturing orders.
- Optionally updates last actual and average costs during manufacturing order close.
- Optional interface allows you to update the General Ledger with WIP adjusting and variance posting when a job is closed.
